

Terms of Reference for the Sunshine Committee – Amended Dec 16, 2009

- A. The Committee will identify those Club members who are hospitalized, convalescing at home, or have deceased, including the death of the Club member's immediate family (a spouse, common-law spouse, son or daughter).
- The committee will arrange for appropriate and timely get - well or sympathy cards. The Committee may visit with the Club member or his immediate family.
 - The committee may inform Club members via requests to sign cards, obits and/or notices maybe posted on the Callie bulletin board, and/or announcements. The Committee will consider and respect the wishes of a Club member or his immediate family if certain information must be treated as confidential.
 - The Club members are encouraged to be vigilant and to notify the Committee of a Club member's death, hospitalization or convalescence at home.
- B. The Committee will identify club members who retire from active curling due to age and/or health issues. Such retired members are encouraged to maintain contact with the Club and to attend and participate in Club social events such as lunches and dinners.
- Maintain a list of retired curlers who are interested to attend Club social events
 - Contact and invite retired curlers to be Guests of the Club Executive at social events
 - Each guest will have the option to maintain membership in the Club and pay applicable membership dues or pay an applicable admission charge for a social event
